AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

The following is a list of proposed after school programs for the 2011-2012 school year.

Homework Club:

The purpose of the homework club is to provide:

- 1) Academic support for students needing assistance*
- 2) A quiet, structured environment*
- 3) Access to computers for assignments and research purposes.*

This club meets Monday-Thursday in the library. There will be a teacher supervisor present.

After School Sports:

This is a fun activity that allows students to participate in group sports competition. This club is run by Ms. Jackson and Mr. Reissfelder. This club runs four times per week for 1 hour from 1:45- 2:45. The club is separated by grade level and activities are co-ed. Students must arrive on time.
